Relatives helped her back to her seat. Others came forward to light sticks of incense and place them on a table between the casket, each brimming with flowers and adorned with stuffed panda bears.

Two yellow-clothed priests from the Cambodian Community of Shokhov stood before the casket and began to chant in Khmer, their voices rising and falling in a mournful melody.

Then the chanting stopped, the priests left and a line in the crowd pushed forward for another look at the tiny bodies. Mok Inn was led away, crying and moaning.

A Christian ceremony for the four Cambodian children will be at 4 p.m. today at the mortuary chapel.

Honing state superintendent of public instruction, also is scheduled to attend.

Residents of blockades are being asked to observe five minutes of silence Monday — one minute for each of the slain children — starting at 11:42 a.m., the approximate time last Tuesday's shooting began.

30 Children Wounded, Gunman Kills Himself

Big-City Mayors Protest Plan For S.F. Boy

A new chapter in what is being called the "school safety" crisis in San Francisco was opened today with the slaying of five children and the wounding of 30 others at a public school in the city's inner city.

The shooting occurred at the 10th and Mission Street School, which is one of the city's poorest and most crowded schools. The school is located in the heart of the city's inner city, near the intersection of 10th and Mission Streets.

The shooting occurred at 11:42 a.m. on Tuesday, January 16, 1979. The gunman, a 19-year-old male, was shot and killed by police officers who arrived on the scene within minutes of the shooting.

The five children who were slain were all between the ages of 10 and 12. The 30 children who were wounded were also between the ages of 10 and 12. The children were all taken to the hospital, where they are receiving medical attention.

The shooting has caused a state of panic in the city. Many parents are keeping their children at home, and many businesses are closed. The city is now on a state of emergency.

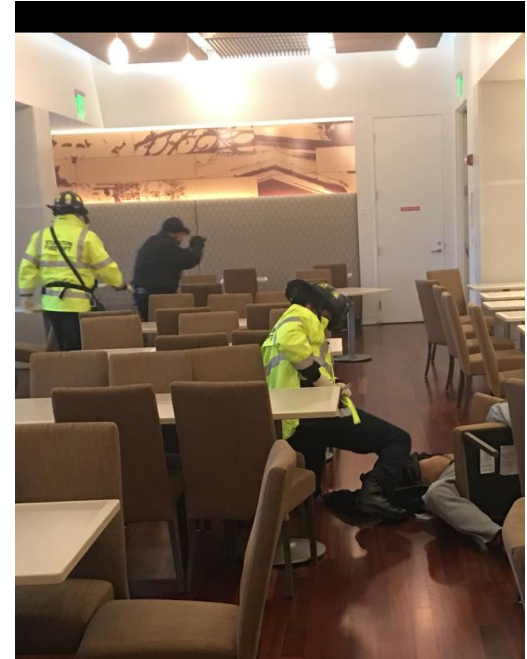
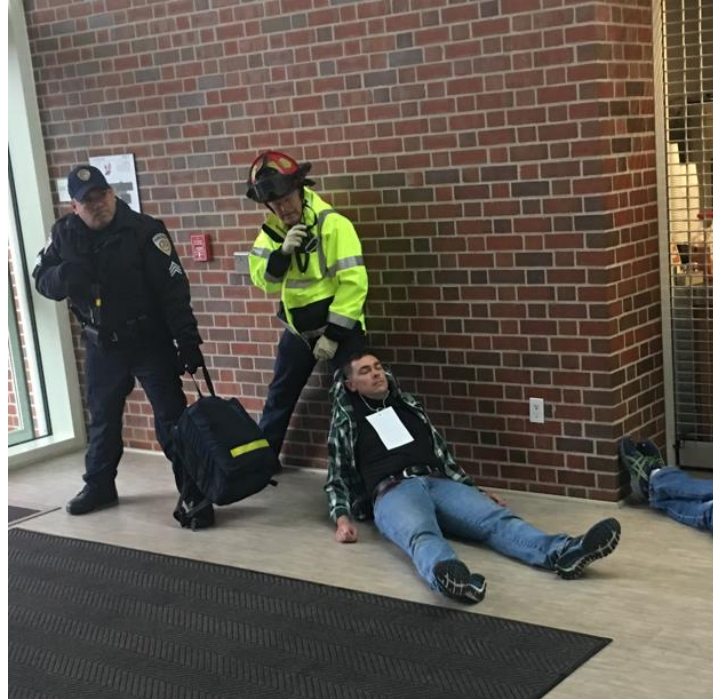
