

Dorian Van Horn will discuss post-COVID concerns about abuse, anger, and suicidal behaviors and how to incorporate those concerns in threat assessment investigations. Investigations can involve ongoing safety concerns to victim(s), to others on campus, to other campuses as well as to school and university personnel. Collaboration is essential when there is a concern for an escalation of violence involving domestic violence, stalking and/or suicidal ideations. Coordination can, and should, incorporate traumainformed interviewing. This session will help you develop workable solutions for enhancing information-sharing and integrated safety




